"BEPS and state aid: a shifting landscape for IP planning"

Mark has carried out many substantive valuations in his career, on both contentious and non-contentious matters, and has been appointed as an expert witness or independent expert to assess damages, valuation or accounting issues in matters before various UK courts, the Competition Appeal Tribunal, the Copyright Tribunal, and the Special Commissioners for Her Majesty's Revenue & Customs.
